Written Essay Prompts:

Answer the following questions in four separate typed paragraphs. Print your answers and attach to the back of the front page of this application.

1. What challenges do you think you might face if you join a group like this? Be honest and specific.
2. Name someone who has impacted or influenced both you and the world in a profound way. What have they done that inspires you and what do you think we can learn from their leadership?
3. What is your proudest accomplishment? How were you able to achieve this?
4. As you know, teacher recommendations are part of our selection process. We will be asking your teachers about your character, work ethic, and behavior. What do you think we will hear about you when we ask your teachers?

Video Submission:

In a video submission using Flipgrid, please answer the following questions. Feel free to be creative in this endeavor.

1. Introduce yourself and describe your personality.
2. Share something you would like us to know about you. What makes you unique?
3. Read the descriptions of each program and visit the class websites. Use this information to tell us why you think you would be a good fit for one or more of these leadership programs at Kinard.
